

2010 PNWLE @ Desert Canyon Golf Resort

MAY 12TH AND 13TH

The Chelan County Sheriff's Office is pleased to invite you and other members of your agency to the 2010 Pacific Northwest Law Enforcement Golf Tournament to be held May 12th and 13th 2010. This year we will play Desert Canyon Golf Resort 1201 Desert Canyon Blvd., Orondo, WA. (Driving directions are listed at desertcanyon.com)

Tournament headquarters and Registration will be at the Desert Canyon Lodge on Desert Canyon Blvd. Registration will be Tuesday, May 11th from 12 noon until 10:00 p.m. (Driving directions are listed at desertcanyon.com).

Desert Canyon Lodge is offering a bed for the first 100 golfers and beds will only be assigned/confirmed by tournament committee after committee receives your payment in full. Rooms and beds are strictly first come, first serve. Once payment is received, committee will contact you and advise whether you are one of the first 100 entries received. Entries will be time stamped here at Chelan County Sheriff's Office in order of receipt. Room assignment requests will be considered by Committee, but not guaranteed. Individuals who wish to arrive earlier than May 11th and/or stay later than May 12th will need to contact Jerry Moore at jerry.moore@co.chelan.wa.us for accommodations which will be \$60.00 per extra night. This \$60.00 per night offer is only available from check-in around noon on May 9th and check out at 11:00 a.m., on May 14th.

Entry fees for the first 100 PNWLE tournament applicants will be \$175 (U.S. funds) and will include a bed for two nights (May 11th and May 12th) 36 holes of golf with golf cart, equipped with GPS, range balls prior to each tournament round, a golf polo shirt, small tee prizes and Thursday's afternoon meal. One practice round per fully paid entry fee for cart fees of \$25.00.

Due to Desert Canyon's allowing such a low entry fee for two rounds of golf and two nights stay, Wednesday and Thursday's afternoon meals will be simple and Thursday's meal will host the golf tournament awards.

Additionally, those applicants entering the tournament after the 100 beds in Desert Canyon Lodge are full, will have to stay in Chelan or Wenatchee and those hotel rates will be in addition to the \$175.00 entry fee. I will supply a list of local hotels at individual requests, so sign up early.

The PNWLE 2010 has arranged what will be an exceptional golfing experience at Desert Canyon's Golf Resort. Desert Canyon Golf Resort is a famous venue which hosted the Cascade Tour (now the Nationwide Tour) in 1999 and 2000 and in 1995 was rated in the top 100 public golf courses in the United States by Golf Digest. The track is an immaculately maintained course that is both challenging, yet fun to play.

Both days of this event will be shotgun starts, starting times to be determined by the number of entrants. This year, the field will be divided into Gross score, three evenly divided handicap divisions. The top three places in each division will be acknowledged.

Side game, May 11th @ 1830 hours: An 18 hole putting competition (for those interested) will take place Tuesday evening, entry fee \$10.00 (U.S. funds) per player, with a cash payout to the top 5 low gross putters. Desert Canyon has an 18 hole Championship putting course.

Side game, May 12th: A 9 hole, two man scramble (for those interested) will take place Wednesday shortly after the second round of golf, entry fee \$10.00 (U.S. funds) per player, with a cash payout to the top 5 gross teams.

Registration is not limited to last year's competitors - all are invited to enter. Please feel free to copy the enclosed application and pass it on to your fellow officers or officers in nearby agencies. The tournament is open to law enforcement officers, active and retired, who have or had arrest powers.

So, get the application/payment back to Jerry Moore 401 Washington Street #1 Wenatchee, WA 98801 (entry fees checks make out to Desert Canyon Golf Resort) and come to Desert Canyon for the 2010 Pacific Law Enforcement Golf Tournament. It should be one of the best ever!

Entry deadline is April 9th, 2010.

A tournament for spouses will be scheduled only if enough interest is shown and will be held on Wednesday at Bear Mountain Golf Course in nearby Lake Chelan. Entry fee for the spousal tourney is

\$ 65.00 (U.S. funds) power cart included. Additionally, spouses not interested in golf, can ride the Lady of the Lake, from Lake Chelan, WA and travel 55 miles up lake to the rural town of Stehekin, WA (flyer included) for \$50.00 (U.S. funds) round trip. This boat ride includes a scenic waterway trip into the North Cascades Mountains.

The Lady of the Lake II runs a 90-minute layover in Stehekin. The Lady II is the largest vessel, she can accommodate up to 275 passengers.

On board you will find a snack bar and restroom facilities. The Lady II has both indoor and outdoor seating with large viewing windows on both the upper and lower decks.

Boarding begins in Chelan 8:00 am

Depart aboard the Lady II 8:30 am

· *IF you choose to take the Rainbow Falls Tour enjoy lunch aboard the boat as you make your way up lake. You can purchase lunch at galley or pack your own lunch or we can provide box lunches for your group.*

Arrive in Stehekin 12:30 pm

· *Take the Rainbow Falls Tour*

-OR-

· *Have lunch at the one of the beautiful lakeside picnic sites or the Stehekin Landing Resort.*

· *Spend the remaining layover at the NPS Golden West Visitor's Center & the Golden West Gallery, or simply relax and enjoy the magnificent views.*

Arrive back in Chelan 6:00 pm
